- The *Ministry of Education and Science* started to implement the **national project** named **"Flyer Kids"** for two years since 2013.
- The **first stage** was realized in **2013** and **over 3500 kids** under **13 years** of age and approximately **350 school teachers** were joined to training short-term courses of **Flyer Kids** for constructing, doing, and flying of simple gliders and rubber light airplane. The training courses are **very attractive** to join school kids and their parents.
- The second stage of the project was starting from 2014 for middle- and high school students to teach how to do and construct the models of F1H and F1A.
- Over 50-60 juniors will participate in the 2015 FAI Mongolia Cup as World Cup event for F1A and F1H EURO Challenge event for F1H. This is a very big event of juniors for the first time in the world. The project's for Flyer Kids advisor is World Champion for F1C, Japanese competitor, Mr. Shigeru Kanegawa.
